Cari Lodge **Commonfund Capital**

As one of very few women to lead a major secondaries investment practice, Cari Lodge has driven one of Commonfund's most active years so far. Under her leadership as managing director and head of secondaries, the firm invested in 50 secondaries deals over the past year, to the tune of around \$500 million. The team also closed Commonfund Capital Secondary Partners III on its \$675 million hard-cap. Since joining the firm in 2013, Lodge and her team have raised \$1.5 billion in secondaries commitments, and completed more than 200 transactions.
